**ADMISSION NOTICE FOR FIRST YEAR OF POST SSC DIPLOMA COURSES IN ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2017-18**

The Government of Maharashtra notified the rules vide Gazette Notification No. TEM-2016/CR 473/16 (Part-2)/TE-4, dated on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2017 to regulate admissions to the First Year of Full Time Professional Diploma Technical Courses in Engineering and Technology. These rules are called the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Education Institution, Regulation of Admission to the professional undergraduate / Diploma / Post Graduate Degree Courses. These rules are also made applicable for admissions in Government and Government Aided institutions vide Government Resolution of Higher & Technical Education Department No. TEM-2016/CR 473/16/TE-4 Dated 25<sup>th</sup> April 2017.

This notification is being issued for Sell of application kit at Facilitation Centers (FC), Online Registration, Documents Verification and Application Form Confirmation at Facilitation Centers (FC), Online Option Form Submission, Confirmation and Acceptance of Seat at Admission Reporting Center (ARC), Reporting to allotted institute by aspiring candidates for admissions to First Year of Full Time Diploma Courses in Engineering and Technology in the Government, Government Aided and Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions for the Academic Year 2017-18 in the Maharashtra State.

**Eligibility Criteria for various types of candidature for admission:**

Maharashtra State/ All India /Jammu & Kashmir Migrant /Children of Indian workers in Gulf Countries (CIWGC) Candidates	OCI / PIO Candidates
(i) The Candidate should be an Indian National. (ii) Passed Secondary School Certificate (SSC) or its equivalent, with at least 35% aggregate marks	Candidates should have Passed Secondary School Certificate (SSC) or its equivalent, with at least 35% aggregate marks

**Important Note:**

- Term Aggregate is defined separately for State Board/ICSE and CBSE candidates in the Information Brochure. Candidates are advised to read online information brochure available on <http://www.dtemaharashtra.gov.in/poly2017> before purchasing application kit.
- For Maharashtra State Board Candidates who have passed Mathematics (Code 71) and Science & Technology (Code 72) are only eligible for admission.
- In case of ICSE & CBSE boards, candidate passed with English, Science and Mathematics is eligible for admission (for additional information refer information Brochure).
- In case of CBSE candidates, who have passed CBSE Std X school level examination shall not be eligible for diploma admissions, as school exam is not treated equivalent/at par exam of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education.

**Online Registration for Admission: -**

1.1 The candidates are required to purchase the Application Kit with Information Brochure from the nearest Facilitation Centre by paying fees as given below.

1.2 OCI/PIO Candidates shall pay the required fees mentioned below only by Credit Card/ Debit Card/ Net Banking etc. through online mode.

<b>General Category</b> Candidates from Maharashtra State, Outside Maharashtra State (OMS), J&K Migrant Candidates, and Children of Indian workers in Gulf Countries (CIWGC).	₹ 400/- (cash)

If candidates do not possess original SSC mark-sheet at the time of document verification at FC, they may show online mark sheet print attested by their institute Headmaster/Principal.</li> <li>All types of candidates aspiring for admission under CAP seats, it is <b>mandatory</b> to get registered and get Documents Verified and application confirmed at designated Facilitation Center. Only those Candidates who have verified and confirmed documents at Facilitation Centers and having CAP Merit number shall be eligible for admission for all types of seats/quota under CAP.</li> <li>As per the Rule No 3 &amp; 13, candidates aspiring for admission for Institutional Quota, vacant seats after CAP, Supernumerary Seats for OCI/PIO, Children of Indian workers in Gulf Countries, Foreign National Candidates, it is a <b>prerequisite &amp; mandatory</b> to get documents verified and confirmed at facilitation centers. ### Important Instructions for Candidate:-

1. The List of the institutes identified as Facilitation Centers (FC) and Admission reporting Centers (ARC) is available on the website.
2. Candidates who do not want to change the options already filled in for CAP Round I or II, their already filled in & confirmed options will be considered for allotment in subsequent rounds.
3. The Information Brochure shall also be available for download on website.
4. The candidates are required to produce the **documents in original** for verification and Confirmation of Application Form at FC. Candidates are advised to keep the necessary documents ready at the time of Documents verification stage as per the notified schedule.
5. The Seat Acceptance Fee shall be Rs. 3,000/- for Candidates of General Category, VJ/DT, NT, SBC/OBC Category and Rs. 1,000/- for SC, ST Category Candidates. The candidate has to pay the Seat Acceptance Fee during first reporting only. This fee shall be transferred to the institution after deducting Rs. 1,000/- towards processing fee.
6. The Seat Acceptance fees is to be paid at ARC through ONLINE MODE only.
7. If candidates fail to confirm online filled application form at FC, then such applications will be rejected and name of such candidates will not appear in the merit list(s) prepared for the purpose of Admission for both CAP as well as Non-CAP process.
8. All Backward Class candidates excluding SC & ST should produce **Non Creamy Layer** certificate **valid up to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018** at the time of verification of documents at FC, if these candidates are not able to produce the Non Creamy Layer certificate, then such candidates will be treated as GENERAL category candidates and such candidates will not be able to claim Reserved seats under the admission process.
9. Application received after the last date from candidates belonging to J & K Migrant candidates will be summarily rejected and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard. J & K Migrant Candidates will get the **Receipt-cum-Acknowledgement** through their login after confirmation of application form.
10. Candidates who have purchased application kit as a reserved category candidate but unable to produce Caste/Tribe certificate for reservation claim during documents verification phase, shall have to pay difference amount of fees of ₹100/- at the FC in cash.

### General Note

1. Candidate can avail the IT facilities free of cost which is available at Facilitation Centre (FC) for submission, confirmation of Application form.
2. All FC's/ARC's shall remain open on all days including holidays and Sundays for submission, confirmation of application form & reporting for seat acceptance respectively during the schedule between 10 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.
3. The schedule displayed above is provisional and may change under unavoidable circumstances.
