**Working of Generative AI:** It relies on advanced machine learning techniques, particularly deep learning and transformer-based architectures such as Generative Adversarial Networks (GANs) and Large Language Models (LLMs).

**GANs** consist of two neural networks (generator and discriminator) that compete, leading to the creation of realistic images or audio.

**LLMs** like GPT learn from massive amounts of text data and generate natural, human-like responses.

**Education :** Personalized learning content, automated assessments, and academic support.

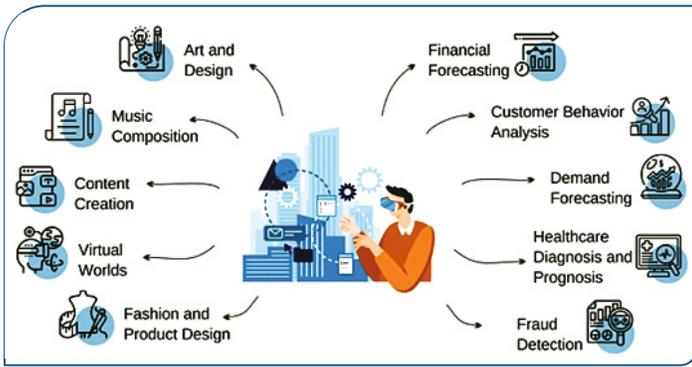
**Healthcare :** Medical imaging analysis, drug discovery and patient communication.
